General:

- Every family has the option to choose **On-Campus or At-Home instruction** for the 2020-21 school year. Parents must select their instructional choice for each of their students by Friday, Aug. 7 via the form emailed on Monday, Aug. 3. Each family is asked to commit to their instructional choice for four weeks (Aug. 19 - Sept. 11) understanding that there is a lot of fluidity in this current environment.
- Due to the increased use of outdoor spaces and the redesign of our locker room protocols, all students are welcome to dress in **CCS spiritwear daily** for the first semester of the 2020-21 school year. All other clothing should adhere to the standard appearance code guidelines.

Lower School

Students may wear CCS T-shirts and sweatshirts or tops with CCS colors (blue, white, gray and black), as well as leggings, athletic pants, sweatpants, and athletic shorts.

- Girls: Athletic shorts must have a minimum three inch inseam. Athletic shorts with revealing high cuts on the sides must be worn over biker shorts/leggings.

Athletic logos and trademark symbols and college-related clothing are permitted. Any other words or markings not related to an athletic company are not permitted.

Middle and Upper School

Students may wear CCS T-shirts and sweatshirts or tops with CCS colors (blue, white, gray and black), as well as athletic pants, sweatpants, and athletic shorts. Tops that are large enough to cover shorts are not permitted. Students may wear athletic pants, sweatpants, and athletic shorts. College sweatshirts are approved attire for any day of the week while college T-shirts are allowed on Fridays.

- Girls: Athletic shorts must have a minimum three inch inseam. Athletic shorts with revealing high cuts on the sides must be worn over biker shorts/leggings. Leggings or yoga pants may not be worn without visible athletic shorts worn over them.

Athletic logos and trademark symbols and college-related clothing are permitted. Any other words or markings not related to an athletic company are not permitted.

- **Face coverings** worn on campus must cover both the mouth and nose. Students must come to school wearing a face covering and will wear them a majority of the time of campus. Face coverings may not have vents, writing, advertising or political statements on them. Face shields are not allowed. We highly encourage parents to stock students' backpacks with several face coverings.
- **Lockers** will not be used at any grade level until further notice.

- **Bathrooms** will be monitored for the number of students in them at a time and will be cleaned at least four times daily.
- Living in a pandemic has been challenging on everyone. Our division counselors are prepared to collaborate with faculty in the support of students' mental health. They will share with our students on this important topic and have resources available for **mental health support** when appropriate.
- **NanoSeptic strips** will be applied to exterior door building entrances. They are safe and non-toxic peel and stick skins that are self-cleaning surfaces that turn dirty, high traffic public touch points into clean areas.
- To start the school year, all **chapels and assemblies** will be virtual and live-streamed into the classrooms.
- **Lunch** will be pre-portioned meals prepared by Flik or delicious entrees served by Flik staff. Additional time has been built into each division lunch schedule to allow for social distancing when students arrive and leave the dining hall. Please see the new lunch schedule for each division below.
- We have increased the hours of our **nursing staff** to ensure proper coverage for all of our campus health needs.
- A student must be **fever free for 48 hours** without the use of fever reducing medicines prior to returning to school.

Lower School:

- Enrichment teachers will travel to lower school classrooms (except P.E.).
- Students in grades 4 and 5 will remain in their homeroom class (cohort) throughout the day while the teachers will rotate to teach their subject matter. Flexible small groups and conferring will allow for differentiated instruction to meet each student at their academic level.
- Gatherings are not allowed for students and parents on campus after school. In order to adhere to social distancing guidelines, we are asking that all students and their parents leave campus once the school day has concluded.
